MESA, Arizona – May 8, 2018 – Mesa Community College (MCC) will recognize the accomplishments of 2,588 graduates, by issuing 4,616 degrees and certificates for the 2017-18 academic year, during a commencement ceremony at 7:15 p.m. on Friday, May 11, in the courtyard of the Southern



and Dobson Campus, 1833 W. Southern Ave., Mesa. The public is invited to the ceremony in which more 600 graduate candidates will participate.

Matt Salmon is the keynote speaker. Salmon, an MCC alumnus and 2017 Hall of Fame honoree, represented the 5th Congressional District of Arizona for five terms and serves Arizona State University as Vice President of Government Affairs.

The Class Honors speaker, Johnathan Speakman, was named to the All-Arizona Academic Team, is one of 20 in the United States named to the All-USA Academic Team and is a 2018 Guistwhite Scholar.

MCC confers associate degrees and certificates of completion. The largest number of associate degrees being bestowed this year are from the Nursing, Emergency Response and Operations, Network System Administration, Administration of Justice, and Audio Production Technology Programs.
