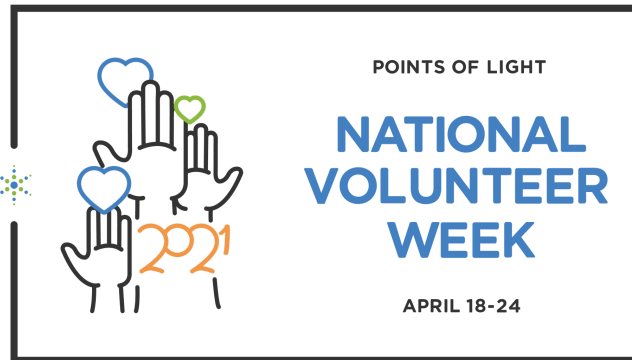


National Volunteer Week

Volunteer Walk of Fame



This year, in honor of National Volunteer Week and each of our dedicated volunteers, we will be placing stars along the sidewalk all throughout downtown Mesa. Each star will represent 8 of our 9,816 volunteers who were engaged in volunteer service last year. City of Mesa volunteers help run vital City programs and services in almost all departments and facilities, such as the Library, Police Department, Mesa Fire and Medical, Parks and Recreation, the Mesa Arts Center, Arizona Museum of Natural History, the i.d.e.a. Museum and through various community revitalization projects and City events. **Each star will be placed six feet apart to represent social distancing and will**

follow a path that leads past many of the City facilities where our volunteers serve. We hope that the Volunteer Walk of Fame will be a great, visual representation of the real-world impact of volunteerism in Mesa. We welcome all to come visit downtown Mesa and take the Volunteer Walk of Fame!

Route Directions

- Begin on the SE corner of Main and Center in front of the Mesa Arts Center
- Cross the street to NE corner of Main and Center by Mesa City Plaza
- Cross the street to go to the NW corner of Main and Center
- Continue along the N side of Main St until you get to Robson
- Turn the corner so you are heading N on the E side Robson St
- Continue up to 1st St next to the i.d.e.a. Museum
- Turn around and head back down Robson
- Turn E at the corner of Robson and Pepper
- Head down Pepper on the N side of the street
- Cross the street at Pepper and Center St so you are on the E side of Center
- Continue on the E side of Center up to 1st St
- Cross the street at Center St heading N to 1st St
- Continue along the N side of 1st St until you get to Centennial
- Cross the street on the W side of Centennial
- Continue down the W side of Centennial to Main St
- Turn the corner and continue down the N side of Main until you reach the NE corner of Main and Center
