The recommended deadline to submit your <u>FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid)</u> (https://fafsa.ed.gov/) is fast-approaching: March 1, 2015.

If you are stuck at a roadblock or looking for help filing out the form, there are professional counselor's that will be teaching workshops this weekend across Arizona, and you don't have to be heading to an Arizona-specific university or college.

According to Arizona State University, there are three mistakes that students and parents make concerning the FAFSA.

- Not filing the FAFSA at all, many families think they make too much money or assume they are not eligible for aid.
- · Leaving a blank field, the most frequent mistake is not putting a "0" as the answer to financial and tax questions.
- · And neglecting to submit related financial aid forms, verification forms may be required to get aid from the national government.

Every student is different. If you decide to attend one of the workshops you need a driver's license, social security number and all 2014 tax forms.
