Mesa student to receive 2014 Flinn Scholarship

Alexander Buckley of Mesa has been named a 2014 Flinn Scholar by the Flinn Foundation. The merit-based scholarship includes the cost of tuition to one of the state's three public universities, room and board, funding for international studies and professional development and university faculty mentorship, according to a press release.

Mr. Buckley is the only student from Mesa among the 20 scholars selected this year. He is set to graduate this month from Red Mountain High School, 7301 E. Brown Road in Mesa.
