The Sun Valley Chorale, directed by Glenn M. Bennett, professor of choral studies, is a community chorus marking its 40th birthday next year. The group Cantilena, also under Bennett's direction, is an audition-only group that has performed in many local venues with such groups as the Tempe Symphony and the Symphony of the Southwest. The Red Mountain Chorale, under the direction of Andrew Briggs, adjunct professor of music and voice who is working on his doctorate in music arts at Arizona State University, also will perform.

Proceeds cover scholarships for music students at MCC.
