"it seems to me that he is not in alignment that you can be a person of faith and also believe that everyone should be treated fairly, that's his responsibility as an elected official" several people have already asked the councilman to step down from his position.he has released an apology...saying quote-- as a practicing catholic it is hard to personally reconcile such issues on a religious perspective.... he goes on to mention that his record shows that he has voted to protect the rights of the l-g-b-t community. and as you can imagine, this story is far from over. we're hearing there will be a press conference later today...so be sure to stay tuned to c-b-s 5 for the latest. an update now on breaking news....more than 30 animals were rescued from a burning home near 75th avenue and bethany home road this week.you wanted to know... what happened to those dogs. well, those animals went back to their owner... who is now trying to find shelters for them. so, will anyone face charges? we're told... no one is facing charges right now... but that could change, as the investigation is on-going.we're also told police have been at this house before. we're working to get more information and will keep you updated. it's kind of an strange place for a scared puppy to hide-- the undercarriage of a police s.u.v.!the dog got spooked when a phoenix police lieutenant honked his horn.he says a group of puppies were running around the streets, causing some traffic problems ...
