

The College of St. Scholastica, a 104-year-old private Catholic Benedictine institution, has commenced its fall semester in Arizona with two milestones: opening a new office in downtown Phoenix, and planning for a first-ever spring social work cohort.

On Nov. 1, St. Scholasticas administrative staff became headquartered at 3550 N. Central Ave., #1020, Phoenix, 85012. Social work faculty already have office space at Mesa Community College (MCC) and Phoenix College. Sixty-five students are working to complete various St. Scholastica degree programs and study areas at those institutions.

St. Scholastica recently began enrolling students for its first-ever spring cohort for social work students at MCC. Enrollment in the Colleges social work program reached an all-time high this fall with 41 students.
