The event takes place at the Mesa Arts Center, One East Main Street in Mesa on Saturday, March 23. The first concert begins at 6 pm and the reception follows for VIPs. The second concert begins at 9:30 p.m. Tickets for the Piano Man Concert are \$25 and tickets for the Captain Squeegie Concert are \$15. Ticket Prices are \$5 higher when purchased at the door. A limited number of \$100 VIP Seats will be available and include admission to both shows, a VIP reception with hors d'oeuvres, meet and greet with the artists and a signed copy of their CDs.
